- Read the account of the giving of materials to the tabernacle in Ex. 35.20-29 and 36.2-7. What strikes you about their generosity? How do you think what happened to them must prior (cf. Ex. 32.1-5; 9-10; 32.14) shape their generosity?
- Read Zacchaeus' story in Luke 19.1-10 and the account of the women in Luke 8.1-3. What fuels their generosity? What makes that kind of glad generosity hard for us at times? How can we protect/recover that? How ought the gospel fuel generosity?
- Share what most motivates you to be generous and what makes it hardest. Spend time praying for one another about this important matter of the heart!
