### Discussion:

- OPTION: discuss the questions on the small group general discussion guide (see below).
- Read ch. 23 aloud. List all the ways you see God's faithfulness referred to (in a positive sense). How does this portrait of God's faithfulness encourage you?
- Read vv. 6, 8 & 11. How are these appropriate responses to God's faithfulness? Which of these is most needful in your life?
- How is God's faithfulness displayed in vv. 12-13, 15-16? How does that affect the way you think about God? about your own obedience?
- What is Joshua concerned might lead the away from faithfully following God's ways (cf. vv. 7, 12)? What are the things that tempt us to unfaithfulness in our culture?
- What most encourages you from this passage? what most challenges you? What is your most significant takeaway?

**Missional Opps!** Challenge your group to love a neighbor well at one of these events!
