READ: 1 Peter 2:4-10

1. In what ways has fear of rejection affected you? Your witness of Christ? (Depending on the closeness of your group, you might ask about past experiences of rejection that contribute to this fear. These could be more or less personal, but maybe a way to get multiple folks involved in the conversation...)
2. How does this passage prepare us to face rejection in witness?
3. How does Peter's example (of failure and restoration) encourage you?
4. Have you found that any of your unchurched acquaintances/friends are interested in some sort of generic spirituality? How do they give expression to this? How might a passage like this help you consider how to affirm their basic interest while challenging them to move beyond spiritual generalities to Christ Himself? How is the Cornerstone different from religion?
5. Do you have a meaningful sense of God's radical acceptance of you? How does this passage help us cultivate this truth in our hearts?
